



# What is WASHplus?

The WASHplus project supports healthy households and communities by creating and delivering interventions that lead to improvements in access, practices, and health outcomes related to water supply, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) and household air pollution (HAP). This five-year project funded through USAID's Bureau for Global Health, uses at-scale programming approaches to reduce diarrheal diseases and acute respiratory infections, the two top killers of children under five years of age globally. WASHplus can integrate WASH and HAP activities into existing education, HIV/AIDS, maternal and child health and nutrition programs and build strong in-country partnerships to increase impact. In addition, WASHplus is charged with promoting and exploring innovation in the WASH and HAP sectors.

## Who We Are

WASHplus is a cooperative agreement managed by the FHI 360 in partnership with CARE and Winrock International, joined by a diverse set of NGO, university, and private sector resource partners. The WASHplus partnership's range of expertise includes:

- Supporting at-scale sanitation initiatives
- Programming rural and urban water supply interventions for domestic and productive uses
- Testing and enhancing cookstoves and associated behaviors to improve household indoor air quality
- Building public-private partnerships for enhanced sustainability
- Incorporating comprehensive behavior change approaches that consider policy, products, and people's preferences
